

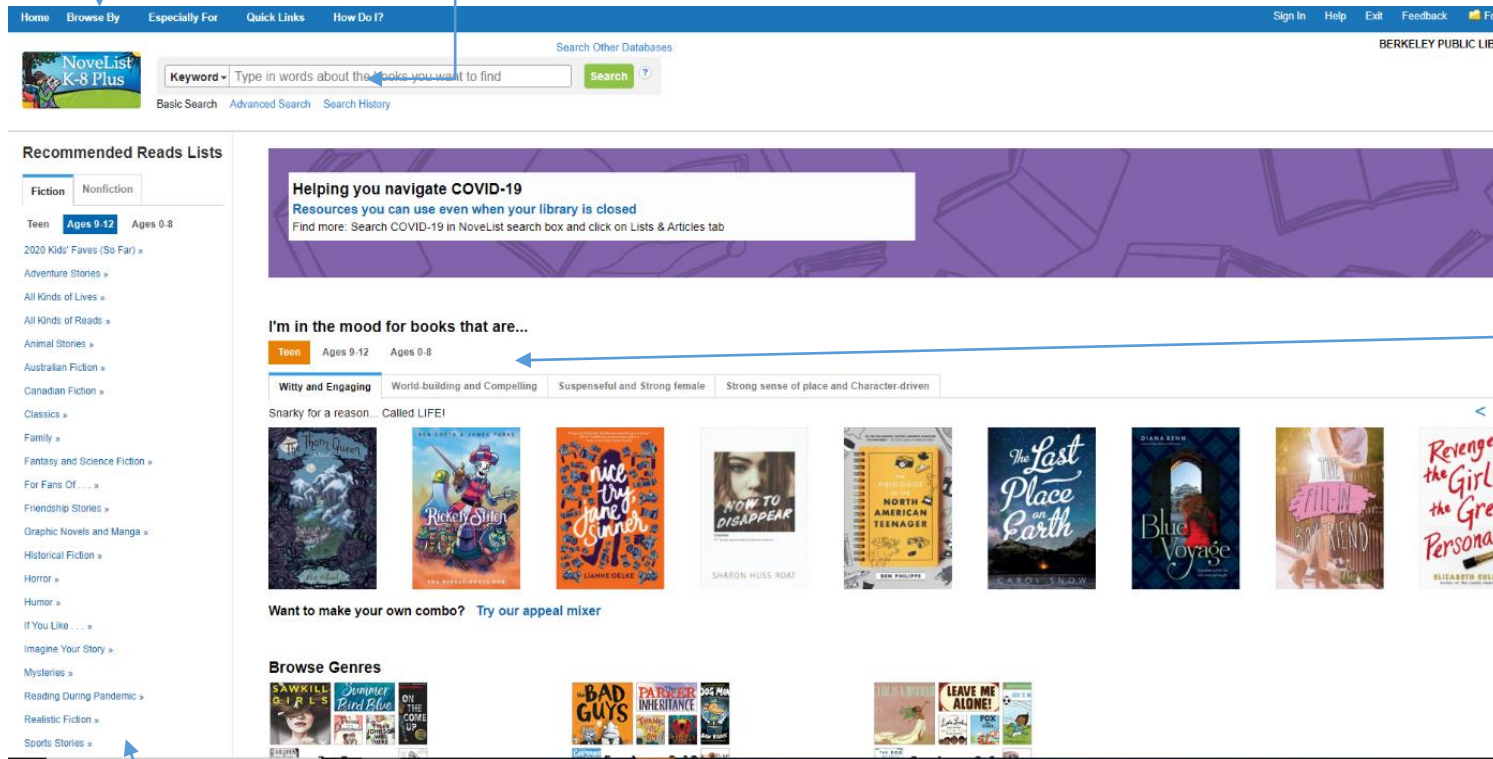





During a long trip home from an agility contest, a car accident sends Tam's kennel flying from the bed of Abby's truck and down a fast-moving creek, leaving him badly injured and alone and Abby in the hospital.
