Who Can Borrow Tools?

The Tool Library is restricted to Berkeley Residents and to people who own property in Berkeley.

To use the Tool Library, bring with you a photo ID, your Berkeley Public Library card and a bill in your name that you have received recently. Tool Library staff confirm your Berkeley esidence in this way. Once confirmed, the Tool Library staff will stamp your Library card with TLL, indicatiing you are cleared to borrow from

the Tool Library.

You must be at least 18 years old to borrow tools.

Borrowing Guidelines

- You must present your library card in order to heckout a tool. Additional ID may be required.
- Lending periods vary from 3-7 days. Check the due date on your receipt.
- Fines vary from \$1 \$15/day
- Most tools may be renewed once. Renew pols online at www.berkeleypubliclibrary.org
- All tools must be returned to the Tool Library during their open hours.
