The City of Berkeley has produced a short video promoting the "**Get Off Your Gas!**" contest, featuring Benjamin Franklin, Berkeley's energy efficiency spokesperson.

This contest is open to all Berkeley residents (homeowners and renters) who have lived in their homes for at least one year, and who use natural gas and receive a PG&E bill. Applicants should use the energy data from their February PG&E bill, received between February 25th and March 24th -- whichever bill has greater number of days in February.

Contest categories include lowest natural gas use, as well as discovering all the creative ways that applicants have successfully used to reduce their natural gas energy consumption. **There will be multiple winners!**
