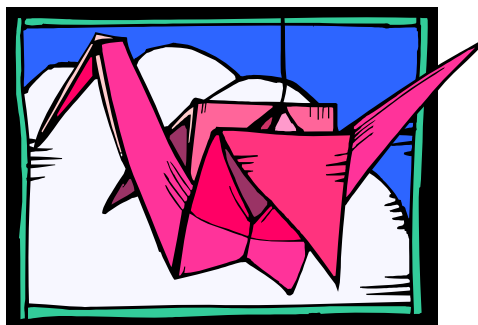


Celebrate Peace Day at the Berkeley Public Library
